GABRIEL DAVIES from Newcastle in the North East of England is Britain's most successful big wave surfer. On Saturday 24th April Gabe Davies will be opening the 'WaveRiders Film Festival' hosted at the Surf Show and introducing the iconic film 'The Drifter'. Gabe will also be talking tall tales and big waves in his workshop on Saturday from 3.30pm to 4.30pm.

After turning professional at the age of 17, Gabriel left the North Sea to embark on a career that has seen him surf across the world. Gabriel has won four British surfing titles, numerous English titles and has represented his nation at the World and European Championships. Moving beyond competition surfing, Gabriel then carved a niche for himself in the challenging pursuit of BIG wave surfing and has divided much of his time between the west coast of Ireland and Hawaii, training to surf waves several storeys high.

While filming Waveriders, Gabriel surfed the biggest wave ever ridden in Ireland and the resulting photograph was nominated for the Billabong XXL Big Wave of the Year Award 2008.
